## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-THREE.

AN ACT to amend section five, of chapter one hundred and fifty, public laws of eighteen hundred and seventy-nine, relative to clerk of courts in Kennebec county.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- SECTION 1. The sixth item of section five, of
- 2 chapter one hundred and fifty, of the public laws
- 3 of the year one thousand, eight hundred and sev-
- 4 enty-nine, is hereby amended so that the same
- 5 shall read as follows:
- 6 "Kennebec: The clerk of Kennebec county is
- 7 to have all fees, as provided by law, from the
- 8 supreme judicial court and superior court for the
- 9 county of Kennebec; and not exceeding two dol-

- 10 lars for each day's attendance upon said courts, to11 be paid from the county treasury."
  - SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when ap-2 proved.
