STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-THREE.

AN ACT in reference to lien on *choses in action* and the enforcement thereof.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section thirty-nine, of chapter ninety-one, of the 2 revised statutes, is hereby amended by striking out 3 the word "article" after the word "any," in the 4 first line of said section, and inserting therein the 5 words "stock or certificate thereof, bond, 6 note, account, or other chose in action, or any 7 other personal property," so that said section as 8 amended shall read as follows:

9 'Sect. 39. Any person having a lien on any 10 stock or certificate thereof, bond, note, account, 11 or other chose in action, or any other personal12 property in his possession, may enforce it by a sale13 thereof, as hereinafter provided.'
