STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-THREE.

AN ACT to establish the manner of calling meetings of village corporations.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. The meetings of any village corpo-

- 2 ration may be notified by the person to whom the
- 3 warrant is directed, by his posting up attested
- 4 copies thereof in two or more public and conspicu-
- 5 ous places within the limits of the corporation,
- 6 seven days before the meeting, instead of as now
- 7 provided by the act creating said corporation;
- 8 provided that such corporation shall first, at a legal
- 9 meeting, designate at what and how many places
- 10 such notices shall be posted.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when ap-2 proved.
