STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-THREE.

AN ACT to amend section first of chapter sixty of the laws of eighteen hundred and eighty-one, in relation to the registry of deeds.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section one of chapter sixty of the public laws of

- 2 eighteen hundred and eighty-one is hereby
- 3 amended by inserting after the word "common-
- 4 wealth," in the fourth line, "or of said common-
- 5 wealth of Massachusetts of the lands of said
- 6 commonwealth of Massachusetts in Maine," so
- 7 that said section as amended shall read as follows:
- 8 Sect. 1. A copy from the records now in the
- 9 land office of a deed from the state of the land of
- 10 the state, or of a deed from the state and the

11 commonwealth of Massachusetts of the undivided 12 lands of the state and said commonwealth or of 13 said commonwealth of Massachusetts of the lands 14 of said commonwealth of Massachusetts in Maine, 15 certified by the land agent or other legal custodian 16 of such records as a true copy of such record, 17 may be filed and recorded in the registry of deeds 18 in the county where the land lies, and shall have 19 the same effect as if the deed itself had been 20 recorded, and certified copies thereof from such 21 registry shall be evidence when the original would 22 be.
