
IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDREL AND EIGHTY-THREE

AN ACT relating to taxes on personal property.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Specification one of section fourteen of chapter

- 2 six of the revised statutes, as amended by chapter
- 3 twenty-eight of the public laws of eighteen
- 4 hundred and eighty-one, is hereby amended so as
- 5 to be as follows:
- 6 First. All personal property employed in trade,
- 7 in the erection of buildings or vessels, or in the
- 8 mechanic arts, shall be taxed in the town where so
- 9 employed on the first day of April in each year;
- 10 provided, the owner, his servant, sub-contractor or
- 11 agent, so employing them, occupies any store,
- 12 shop, mill, wharf, landing place or ship yard
- 13 therein for the purpose of such employment.
