STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-THREE.

AN ACT to allow women to vote in the election of school officers.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Every woman who is a citizen of the state, of

- 2 twenty-one years of age and upwards, (except
- 3 persons excluded by section one of article two of
- 4 the constitution for causes other than of sex) who
- 5 has resided in the state for the term of three
- 6 months next preceding any election of school offi-
- 7 cers in any town or plantation where her residence
- 8 is so established, shall have the right to vote in
- 9 the election of such officers.
