RESOLVE in favor of St. Elizabeth Orphan Asylum of Portland.

Resolved, That the sum of eight hundred dollars

- 2 be and is hereby appropriated for the benefit of
- 3 the St. Elizabeth Orphan Asylum of Portland, and
- 4 the support of soldier's and sailor's orphans therein,
- 5 of which there shall be paid the sum of four hun-
- 6 dred dollars in the year eighteen hundred and
- 7 eighty-three, and the sum of four hundred dollars
- 8 in the year eighteen hundred and eighty-four.

Statement relating to foregoing resolve as per statement of Bishop James A. Healy, President of St. Elizabeth Orphan Asylum of Portland.

That said asylum is now supporting seventy orphan children, several of which are orphans of soldiers and sailors. That for past two years the state has rendered aid to the extent of four hundred dollars per year, and we believe the above aid right and proper and should be continued as per resolve.
