STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE entitled a resolve in aid of the children's
home at Bangor.

Resolved, That the sum of two thousand dollars
2 be, and hereby is appropriated for the support of
3 soldier's orphans at the "Children's Home" in
4 Bangor. Of which there shall be paid the sum of
5 one thousand dollars during the year eighteen hun-
6 dred eighty-three, and one thousand dollars during
7 the year eighteen hundred and eighty-four.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The Children's Home of Bangor, although endowed largely by citizens of Bangor, is not a local institution, but receives children from all parts of this State. Its endowments yield a revenue of about \$3,000 per year. It has under its care about 40 children, whose support and care cost about \$100 each. The managers therefore feel that they have a just claim for assistance from the State.
