STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE making an appropriation to build a bridge
across the Wytapitlock stream, county of Aroos-
took.

Resolved, That the sum of eight hundred dollars
2 be and is hereby appropriated to build a bridge
3 across the Wytapitlock stream and its branches on
4 the Military road in township number one in range
5 three, county of Aroostook, said sum to be ex-
6 pended under the direction of the county commis-
7 sioners of said county.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The Wytapitlock stream is crossed twice by the Old Military road from Lincoln to Houlton, and the State of Maine obligated itself to the United States Government, by resolve number 49 in 1834, upon assuming the ownership of said road, to keep it in repair.

The bridges across said stream are very much out of repair, and unsafe for travel; therefore the citizens of said township ask for an appropriation by the Legislature for that purpose.
