STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-THREE.

AN ACT to regulate the taking of shell fish.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. Any town may at any town meeting

- 2 fix the times in which shell fish may be taken
- 3 within the limits of such town, and may fix the
- 4 prices for which the municipal officers shall grant
- 5 permits therefor, and may by vote allow residents
- 6 of the town to take shell fish without a written
- 7 permit. But this act shall not interfere with any
- 8 provisions of law relating to the taking of shell
- 9 fish for bait by fishermen.

SECT. 2. Any person who takes shell fish, not

- 2 being authorized thereto by law, shall be punished
- 3 for each offence by a fine of not more than ten

- 4 dollars or by imprisonment not more than thirty
- 5 days or both.
