STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE to furnish certain books to the town of Dresden.

Resolved, That the secretary of state be directed 2 to furnish to the town of Dresden, the following 3 books: volumes fifteen, twenty-one, twenty-six, 4 twenty-seven, twenty-eight, twenty-nine, forty-5 four, forty-five, forty-six, forty-eight, fifty-one, 6 fifty-two of the Maine Reports; and the Acts and 7 Resolves of eighteen hundred and forty, forty-one, 8 forty-two, forty-three, forty-four, forty-five, forty-9 eight, fifty-three, fifty-four, fifty-five, sixty-one, 10 sixty-two, sixty-three, sixty-seven, seventy-three, 11 seventy-five, seventy-six, seventy-seven, and the 12 private and special laws from eighteen hundred and 13 twenty to eighteen hundred and forty-five inclusive, 14 so far as the same or any part thereof can be so 15 furnished without injury to the state.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The town of Dresden, by fire, has lost a portion of the reports and other documents once its property, and the inhabitants, through their selectmen, appreciating their value, now ask that they be supplied, and they will take reasonable care to have them preserved for the use of the inhabitants of the town.
