STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in aid of building a bridge in the town of Madawaska.

Resolved, That the sum of two hundred and fifty

- 2 dollars be and is hereby appropriated to aid in
- 3 building a bridge across the Vital Dufour stream
- 4 in the town of Madawaska, county of Aroostook,
- 5 and that said sum be expended under the direction
- 6 of the county commissioners of said county.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

This stream crosses one of the main travelled mail routes in the town of Madawaska. The town is so laid out that it has four roads running through it crossed by several streams over which expensive bridges have to be built. The people are mostly poor and unable to build and keep them in repair without aid from the State. Therefore they ask the Legislature to grant them a small appropriation.
