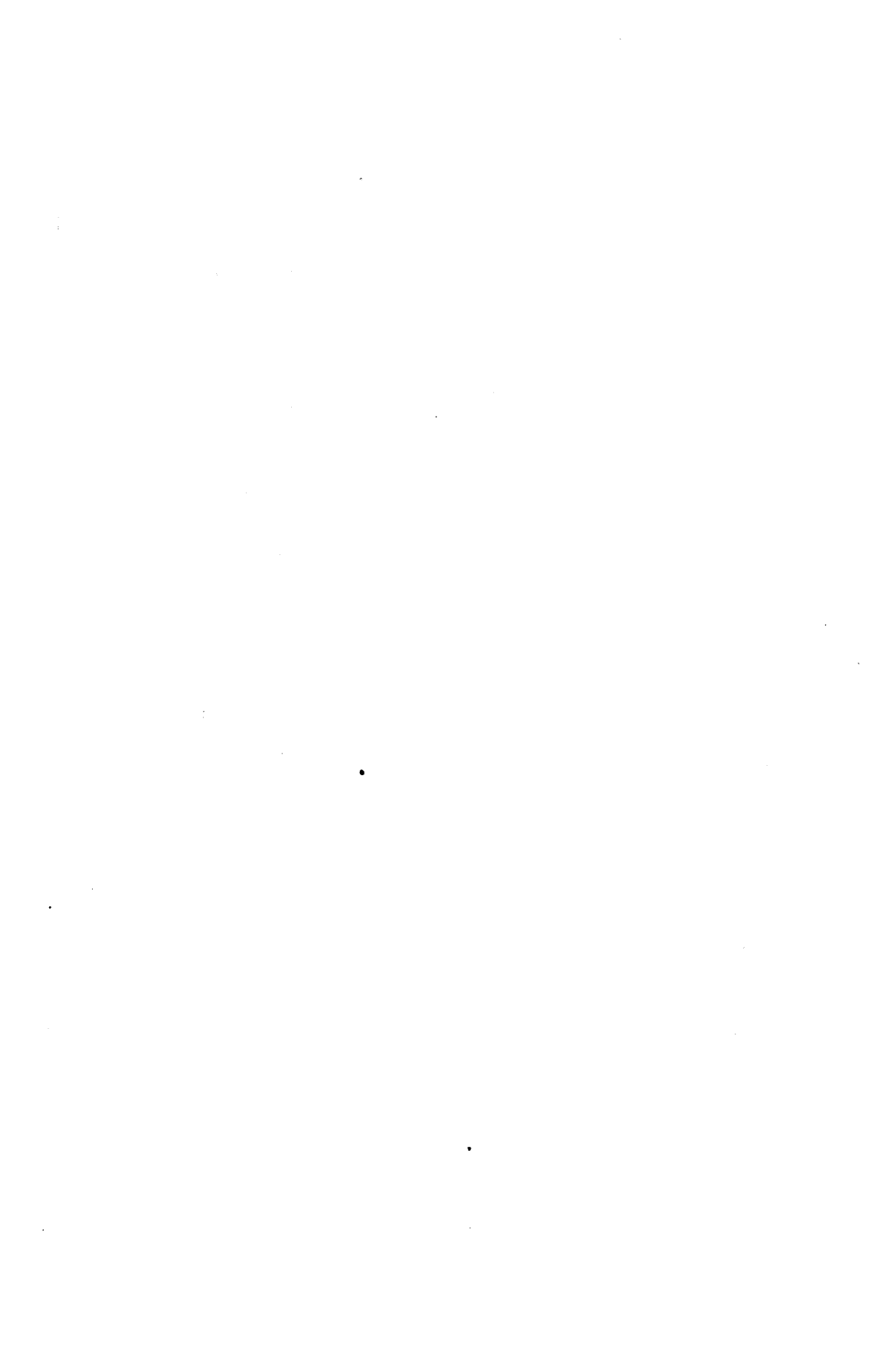
## STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of the town of Harpswell.

*Resolved,* That there be paid by the treasurer of  
2 state, out of the school funds for the current year,  
3 to the town of Harpswell, the sum of thirty-one  
4 dollars and forty cents, it being a balance in equity,  
5 due said town as its proportion of the school funds  
6 for the year eighteen hundred and eighty-two.
