STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-THREE.

AN ACT to excuse corporations, which have ceased to transact business, from publishing semi-annual statements and filing annual returns.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

The Attorney general, upon application by any

- 2 corporation, and satisfactory proof that such cor-
- 3 poration has ceased to transact all business, shall
- 4 file a certificate of the fact with the secretary of
- 5 state, and upon being paid reasonable compensa-
- 6 tion for his services, shall give a duplicate thereof
- 7 to the corporation; and thereupon such corpora-
- 8 tion shall be excused from thereafter publishing
- 9 semi-annual statements, and filing annual returns
- 10 with the secretary of state, as now required by
- 11 law, so long as its franchises remain unused.
