STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-THREE.

AN ACT to amend section three of chapter one hundred and twenty-five of the public laws of eighteen hundred and seventy-nine, relating to salaries.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section three of chapter one hun-2 dred and twenty-five of the public laws of eighteen 3 hundred and seventy-nine is hereby amended by 4 striking out the words "one hundred and fifty," 5 and by inserting instead thereof the words "two 6 hundred;" also by striking out the words "said 7 officers named in this section are to do and per-8 form all services similar to those done by the offi-9 cers who held these positions for the legislature of 10 eighteen hundred and seventy-eight;" so that the11 same section, amended, shall be as follows:

12 Sect. 3. Secretary of the senate and the clerk 13 of the house of representatives, six hundred dol-14 lars each, in full for all services; assistant secre-15 tary and assistant clerk, three hundred dollars 16 each, in full for all services; messenger and assis-17 tant messengers to senate and to house, two hun-18 dred dollars to each in full.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when ap-2 proved.
