## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-THREE.

AN ACT to amend chapter one hundred and fiftyeight of the laws of eighteen hundred and seventyseven.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section one, part tenth, is hereby
- 2 amended by striking out of the sixth line the words
- 3 "of a debtor or debtors residing or," and by insert-
- 4 ing in the seventh line after the word "state" the
- 5 words "of a debtor or debtors," so that the same
- 6 shall read as follows:
- 7 Tenth. In suits for the redelivery of goods or
- 8 chattels, taken and detained from the owner, and
- 9 secreted or withheld, so that the same cannot be
- 10 replevied, and in bills in equity by a creditor or

11 creditors to reach and apply in payment of a debt,
12 any property, right, title, or interest, legal or
13 equitable, found within this state, of a debtor or
14 debtors, which cannot be come at to be attached
15 on a writ or taken on execution in a suit at law
16 against such debtor or debtors, and which is not
17 exempt by law from such attachment and seizure,
18 and any property or interest conveyed in fraud of
19 creditors.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when ap-2 proved.
