STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND . BIGHTY-THREE.

AN ACT relating to Immigration.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Whenever the governor of the state shall have 2 knowledge that, under the provisions of an act of 3 Congress approved August three, eighteen hun-4 dred and eighty-two, officers are necessary in any 5 town or city to take charge of the local affairs of 6 immigration in the ports of this state and to pro-7 vide for the support and relief of immigrants who 8 shall fall into distress, he shall designate for such 9 duty the board of overseers of the poor and their 10 successors in such town or city, or any member or 11 members of such board.
