## STATE OF MAINE.

1N THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-THREE.

AN ACT to amend the second section of chapter fifty-three of the public laws of the year one thousand eight hundred and seventy-eight.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. The second section of chapter fifty-2 three of the public laws of the year eighteen 3 hundred and seventy-eight is hereby amended by 4 inserting next before the word "coupons," in the 5 second line of said section, the words "over due," 6 so that said section as amended shall read as fol-7 lows:

8 Sect. 2. The capital stock of such new corpora-9 tion shall be equal to the amount of unpaid bonds 10 and over due coupons secured by such mortgage, 11 taken at their face at the time of the organization 12 of the new corporation, and the amount required 13 to redeem any prior mortgage, and shall be divided 14 into shares of one hundred dollars each. All stock 15 issued under the provisions of this act shall be 16 taken and considered as paid in full, and shall not 17 be liable to further assessment; and no person 18 taking or holding the same shall by reason thereof 19 be liable for the debts of such corporation.

SECT. 2. This act takes effect when approved.
