STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-THREE.

AN ACT to amend section seventeen of chapter fiftyeight of the revised statutes relating to the appointment of constables, at meetings of county and local agricultural societies.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section seventeen of chapter fifty-eight of the re-2 vised statutes is hereby amended by striking out 3 the words "inhabitants of the county," so that the 4 section as amended shall read as follows:

5 Sect. 17. The officers of any such society may 6 appoint a sufficient number of suitable persons, to 7 act as constables at cattle shows and exhibitions; 8 and they shall have and exercise all the powers of 9 constables, in relation to the preservation of the 10 public peace, and enforcing the rules and regula-11 tions of said society, within the towns where such 12 shows and exhibitions are held, from twelve o'clock 13 at noon of the day preceding the commencement 14 of such shows and exhibitions, and until twelve 15 o'clock at noon of the day succeeding the termina-16 tion thereof and no longer.
