STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-THREE.

AN ACT to amend an act entitled an act to amend section fifty-five, chapter forty-nine of the revised statutes relating to foreign insurance companies.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

That section fifty-five, chapter forty-nine of the

- 2 revised statutes as amended in eighteen hundred
- 3 and seventy-four, section two hundred and seven,
- 4 shall be amended by striking out the word "the"
- 5 in the third line of said section, and inserting the
- 6 words "each and every," so that said section shall
- 7 as amended read as follows:
- 8 Sect. 55. Every foreign insurance company
- 9 doing business in this state, shall annually cause to
- 10 be published three weeks successively in some daily

11 or weekly paper printed in each and every county
12 where said company has a duly authorized agent,
13 or takes policies, a condensed statement of its con14 dition conformable to its last annual report to the
15 commissioner; and any such insurance company
16 which shall neglect or refuse to publish such state17 ment shall forfeit not less than fifty dollars.
