IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-THREE.

AN ACT to amend section three of chapter fifty-nine of the revised statutes relating to the intermarriage of white persons with negroes, mulattoes and Indians.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section three of chapter fifty-nine of the revised

- 2 statutes, is hereby amended by striking out in the
- 3 first and second lines, the words following: "no
- 4 white person shall intermarry with a negro, Indian
- 5 or mulatto and," so that said section as amended
- 6 shall read "no insane person or idiot shall be cap-
- 7 able of contracting marriage."
