AN ACT to re-establish solitary imprisonment in the state prison.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Chapter sixty-four of the public laws of eighteen 2 hundred and seventy-two is hereby repealed, and 3 the provisions of revised statutes of eighteen hun-4 dred and seventy-one, providing for solitary im-5 prisonment in the state prison, are hereby revived 6 and re-enacted.
