STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE for an appropriation for Limington bridge.

Resolved, That the sum of two thousand and five

- 2 hundred dollars (\$2,500,) be and hereby is appro-
- 3 priated to the the town of Limington, to build one-
- 4 half of bridge known as "Limington bridge" in
- 5 said town; provided, the said town raises an equal
- 6 sum for building said bridge, said sum to be ex-
- 7 pended under direction of county commissioners.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

This bridge is on a county road, and main thoroughfare for four towns to get to their market. Said town has three bridges respectively which it wholly supports, viz: one seventy-five feet long, one ninety feet long and one ninety-five feet long; and in addition has the following bridges which she half supports: one fifty-four feet long, one one hundred and fifty feet long and one two hundred and sixty-four feet long, the latter being the one for which an appropriation is asked. The town is heavily in debt, and its taxes for the last five years have averaged .026 6-10. Our half of bridge to be built, according to estimates taken, will cost \$5,000, therefore we ask for an appropriation.
