## STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE laying a tax on the counties of the state for the years eighteen hundred and eighty-three and eighteen hundred and eighty-four.

---

*Resolved,* That the sums annexed to the counties 2 in the following schedule are hereby granted as a 3 tax on each county respectively, to be appropria- 4 ted, assessed, collected, and applied for the pur- 5 pose of paying the debts and necessary expenses 6 of the same, and other purposes ordered by law, 7 for the year one thousand eight hundred and 8 eighty-three, to wit: Androscoggin, thirty thou- 9 sand dollars; Aroostook, sixteen thousand dollars; 10 Cumberland, thirty thousand dollars; Franklin, 11 seven thousand dollars; Hancock, eleven thou- 12 sand five hundred dollars; Knox, twenty-three 13 thousand dollars; Kennebec, thirty-six thousand 14 dollars; Lincoln, nine thousand dollars; Oxford,

15 eleven thousand dollars; Penobscot, twenty-five  
 16 thousand dollars; Piscataquis, six thousand five  
 17 hundred dollars; Sagadahoc, fifteen thousand dol-  
 18 lars; Somerset, fourteen thousand dollars; Wash-  
 19 ington, thirteen thousand dollars; Waldo, four-  
 20 teen thousand six hundred dollars; York, twenty  
 21 thousand dollars.

22 For the year one thousand eight hundred and  
 23 eighty-four, the following sums, to wit: Andro-  
 24 scoggin, thirty thousand dollars; Aroostook, six-  
 25 teen thousand dollars; Cumberland, thirty thou-  
 26 sand dollars; Franklin, seven thousand dollars;  
 27 Hancock, eleven thousand five hundred dollars;  
 28 Knox, twenty-three thousand dollars; Kennebec,  
 29 thirty-six thousand dollars; Lincoln, nine thou-  
 30 sand dollars; Oxford, eleven thousand five hun-  
 31 dred dollars; Penobscot, twenty-five thousand  
 32 dollars; Piscataquis, six thousand five hundred  
 33 dollars; Sagadahoc, fifteen thousand dollars;  
 34 Somerset, fourteen thousand dollars; Washing-  
 35 ton, thirteen thousand dollars; Waldo, fourteen  
 36 thousand six hundred dollars; York, twenty  
 37 thousand dollars.
