STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE instructing the secretary of state to purchase reports of Maine Historical Society.

That the secretary of state is authorized to con-2 tract with the Maine Historical Society for the 3 volumes of its proceedings and collections to be 4 hereafter published, and commencing with volume 5 eight heretofore issued; *provided*, they can be pur-6 chased at a price not exceeding one dollar and fifty 7 cents per volume, containing not a less number of 8 pages than said eighth volume, and further *pro-*9 *vided*, that the aggregate amount paid in any one 10 year shall not exceed one thousand dollars. Said 11 volumes shall be distributed by the secretary of 12 state, in the same way, and to the same parties, that 13 he is now authorized to distribute the acts and re-14 solves of the state legislature. • -it -
