STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of the town of Mayfield.

Resolved, That the sum of three hundred dollars
2 be and is hereby appropriated out of the treasury,
3 and expended under the direction of the county
4 commissioners to aid in completing the road from
5 Mayfield, in Somerset county, to Kingsbury Mills, in
6 Piscataquis county, as located by the county com-
7 missioners of Somerset and Piscataquis counties;
8 *provided*, the town of Mayfield raise and cause to
9 be expended on said road to the satisfaction of the
10 county commissioners of said county, the sum of
11 one hundred and fifty dollars.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The road from Mayfield, in Somerset county, to Kingsbury Mills, in Piscataquis county, was located some four years ago by the commissioners of the two counties. There have been about eight hundred dollars expended on the road. So far as built is well done. Three hundred dollars of the amount expended was given by the State; the balance was raised by the town. They were compelled to stop work for want of means. With the aid asked for and what the town must do, the road can be finished. Without it the completion must be postponed. Statistics show the town to have the least number of inhabitants, the smallest valuation and least voters of any town in Somerset county.
