## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-THREE.

AN ACT to incorporate the Drummond Pond Ice Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. That James Andrews, Charles L. 2 Marston, M. G. Palmer, John E. Palmer and 3 Zepher Folsom, their associates and assigns, be 4 and hereby are incorporated a body corporate by 5 the name of Drummond Pond Ice Company, with 6 authority to build and maintain a dam to exclude 7 entirely the tide water from said pond in Phipps-8 burg, near the old dam, used formerly to retain the 9 tide water (used for running saw mill and grist 10 mill,) for the purpose of creating an ice pond, with 11 the authority to build suitable wharves, piers, and 12 other erections that may facilitate the getting and 13 shipping of ice, and that said dam may be of such 14 height as to flow the fresh water four feet above 15 the original flow of tides on the marshes adjoining 16 the said Drummond Mill Creek so called, and said 17 company may hold real and personal estate to the 18 value of fifty thousand dollars for the prosecuting 19 of its business.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when ap-2 proved.
