RESOLVES relating to the treaty land known as the John Mathison lot, in township number nine, range five, in the county of Aroostook.

Resolved, That the Land Agent be and is hereby

- 3 to the heirs of the late John Mathison," approved
- 4 January twenty-ninth, eighteen hundred and sixty-
- 5 eight, is hereby repealed.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

Mr. Swett has resided on this land for eleven years and claims to be entitled to a deed of the same from the State, and is supported in his claim by Mr. Ambrose, of Sherman, representative from that district. This resolve is for the purpose of putting the matter into the Land Agent's hands for investigation and action.
