STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
EIGHTY-THREE.

AN ACT to amend section twenty-nine of chapter
seventy-four of the public laws of eighteen hundred
and seventy-eight, entitled “an act in relation to
the insolvent laws of Maine.”

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

Section twenty-nine of chapter seventy-four of
2 the public laws of eighteen hundred and seventy-
3 eight is hereby amended by striking out the
4 following words from the first part of said section,
5 viz: “upon the application, in writing, of one or
6 more creditors, representing one-fourth part of the
7 amount of debts proved,” so that said section as
8 amended shall read as follows:

(2)

9 *Sect. 29.* The judge shall require the assignee
10 to give a bond for the faithful performance of his
11 duties, in such sum as he shall direct and with
12 such sureties as he shall approve.
