AN ACT relative to banks.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

When thereto required by the examiner, the cashier of
2 each bank shall make a transmit to him, within the time
3 directed in such requisition, a return of the state of such
4 bank, stating the several particulars mentioned in the fol-
5 lowing form, exhibiting in distinct columns the amounts
6 due from the bank, and the resources of the bank, viz :

8 urday of ———, 18—, at two o'clock P. M.
