## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-THREE.

AN ACT to amend chapter one hundred and twenty of the public laws of eighteen hundred and seventy-six, relating to the formation of railroad corporations.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Any railroad corporation which has been or may 2 hereafter be formed and organized under the pro3 visions of chapter one hundred and twenty of the 4 public laws of eighteen hundred and seventy-six 5 with a narrow gauge, may change its gauge to the 6 standard gauge of four feet eight and one-half 7 inches, subject to the approval of the railroad 8 commissioners.
