STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in relation to conveyances to Swedish settlers.

Resolved, That the land agent be and is hereby 2 authorized, under direction of the governor and 3 council, to convey lots to the Swedish settlers that 4 have occupied them under the acts of eighteen 5 hundred and seventy, eighteen hundred and 6 seventy-one, eighteen hundred and seventy-two 7 and eighteen hundred and seventy-three, and have 8 in good faith performed all the settling duties reguired by law, and appear to be justly and equit-10 ably entitled to deeds, which have been withheld 11 in consequence of some informality, or failure of 12 the local agent to comply with the terms of the 13 law.
