STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-THREE.

AN ACT in addition to chapter fourteen revised statutes relating to contagious diseases in cattle, relating to compensation of commissioners.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. The commissioners shall receive 2 reasonable compensation for services rendered in 3 the discharge of their duties, to be audited and 4 allowed by the governor and council.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when ap-2 proved by the governor. • . .
