## STATE OF MAINE.

#### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-THREE.

AN ACT to amend section nine of chapter fifty-nine of the revised statutes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section nine of chapter fifty-nine of the revised 2 statutes, by inserting after the word "chapter" in 3 the second line the words "or the provisions of 4 chapter sixty," so that said section as amended 5 shall read as follows:

6 Sect. 9. When residents of this state with in-7 tent to evade the provisions of sections one, two 8 and three of this chapter or the provisions of 9 chapter sixty, and to return and reside here, go 10 into another state or country, and there have their 11 marriage solemnized, and afterwards return and12 reside here, such marriage shall be void in this13 state.
