STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-THREE.

AN ACT to amend section six of chapter one hundred and fifty of the laws of eighteen hundred and seventy-nine, relating to compensation of county commissioners.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section six of chapter one hundred and fifty of

- 2 the laws of eighteen hundred and seventy-nine is
- 3 amended by striking out the word "two" in the
- 4 first line and inserting in place thereof the words
- 5 "two dollars and fifty cents," so that said section
- 6 as amended shall read as follows:
- 7 Sect. 6. Each commissioner shall receive two
- 8 dollars and fifty cents a day while actually em-
- 9 ployed in the service of the county, including the
- 10 time spent in travelling, for which he shall have

11 eight cents a mile for the distance actually trav12 elled; but he shall not have more than one travel
13 in the same hearing or session, nor for more than
14 two adjournments of any regular term, nor for
15 service or travel on more than one petition or case
16 at the same time, nor anything for travel or
17 attendance at the legislature connected with the
18 annual county estimates, nor for any additional
19 trouble or expense of any kind.
