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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND  
EIGHTY-THREE.

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AN ACT to amend section fourteen of chapter sixty-five of the revised statutes, relating to distribution of estates.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

Section fourteen of chapter sixty-five of the  
2 revised statutes is amended by adding after the  
3 word "devisee," in the first line, the words "or  
4 any one claiming under such heir or devisee," so  
5 that said section as amended shall read as follows:  
6 *Sect. 14.* If the share of any such heir or de-  
7 visee, or any one claiming under such heir or  
8 devisee, is under attachment, the judge, on like  
9 application from the plaintiff in the suit, or the  
10 attaching officer, shall require the money, not ex-

11 ceeding the amount of the attachment, to be paid  
12 to the officer, who shall be answerable therefor in  
13 his official capacity subject to the rights of the  
14 parties, as if originally attached.
