STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-THREE.

AN ACT to amend section forty-four, chapter fortynine of the revised statutes, relating to insurance.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Section forty-four, chapter forty-

- 2 nine of the revised statutes, as amended by chapter
- 3 sixty-three, acts of eighteen hundred and eighty-
- 4 one, is hereby amended so as to read as follows:
- 5 Sect. 44. An insurance commissioner shall be ap-
- 6 pointed by the governor and council, who shall hold his
- 7 office three years, unless sooner removed, but shall
- 8 not at the same time be examiner of banks. His
- 9 office shall be at the state capitol. The salary of
- 10 the insurance commissioner shall be twelve hun-
- 11 dred dollars per annum, payable quarterly by the

12 state treasurer, on the first day of January, April,
13 July and October of each year. The governor
14 and council may allow such reasonable sum for
15 postage and expenses incurred in enforcing the
16 laws relating to insurance, as they deem proper.
17 The insurance commissioner may administer oaths
18 in the performance of his official duties, in any
19 part of the state and at any time. He shall keep
20 a correct account of all his doings, and of all fees
21 and monies received by him, by virtue of his office,
22 and pay the same over to the state treasurer quar23 terly, and at the same time settle his accounts with
24 the governor and council. He shall give bond to
25 the treasurer, in the sum of five thousand dollars,
26 for the faithful discharge of his duties.

SECT. 2. Chapter sixty-three of the acts of 2 eighteen hundred and eighty-one is hereby repealed, 3 except for the settlement of matters already affected 4 by it.

SECT. 3. This act takes effect when approved.
