

STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE for the appointment of commissioners on the tax laws.

Resolved, That the governor, with the advice of

- 2 the council, appoint three commissioners, whose
- 3 duty it shall be to examine the general subject of
- 4 taxation, ascertain, so far as may be, the practical
- 5 workings of the various tax laws in the several
- 6 states, and report to the next legislature what
- 7 additions to, or modifications in, the present law, if
- 8 any, are in their judgment needed to ensure a full
- 9 and equal taxation of property in the state.
