STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE for the appointment of commissioners on
the tax laws.

Resolved, That the governor, with the advice of
2 the council, appoint three commissioners, whose
3 duty it shall be to examine the general subject of
4 taxation, ascertain, so far as may be, the practical
5 workings of the various tax laws in the several
6 states, and report to the next legislature what
7 additions to, or modifications in, the present law, if
8 any, are in their judgment needed to ensure a full
9 and equal taxation of property in the state.
