IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-THREE.

AN ACT to amend section twenty-nine of chapter seventy-seven of the revised statutes, relative to the reporter of decisions.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

That section twenty-nine of chapter seventy-seven

- 2 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by
- 3 inserting therein between the words "argued" and
- 4 "reporting" in the third line thereof, the following
- 5 words: "in case of exceptions, stating the name of
- 6 the justice to whose ruling the exception is taken,"
- 7 and inserting in the fourth line thereof, between
- 8 the words "importance" and "he," the following
- 9 words: "and stating therein the names of counsel
- 10 as entered upon the law docket."
