STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-THREE.

AN ACT to amend section fifty-one of chapter sixtyfour of the revised statutes, relating to the appointment of special commissioners on disputed claims against estates of deceased persons not insolvent.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Such claimant shall have the same right to apply

- 2 to the judge of probate, and the same proceed-
- 3 ings shall be had on such application, after notice
- 4 to the other party, as are provided for the execu-
- 5 tor or administrator in this section, if the claimant
- 6 has demanded payment of his claim, and it is not
- 7 complied with for thirty days, or is refused.
