STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-THREE.

AN ACT to amend section forty of chapter ninetyone of the revised statutes, relating to liens on goods in possession.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section forty of chapter ninety-one of the revised

- 2 statutes, is hereby amended in the second line
- 3 thereof by inserting after the word "judicial," the
- 4 words "or superior," so that said section as
- 5 amended shall read as follows:
- 6 Sect. 40. The person claiming the lien may file
- 7 in the supreme judicial or superior court in the
- 8 county where he resides, or in the office of the
- 9 clerk thereof, a petition briefly setting forth the

- 10 nature and amount of his claim, a description of
- 11 the article possessed, and the name and residence
- 12 of its owners, if known to him, and a prayer for
- 13 process to enforce his lien.
