STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-THREE.

AN ACT to prohibit the sale of toy pistols.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Whoever has in his possession a toy pistol for the

- 2 explosion of percussion caps or blank cartridges,
- 3 with intent to sell the same, or sells or offers to
- 4 sell or give away the same, shall be fined not less
- 5 than five nor more than one hundred dollars; and
- 6 such person shall be liable for all damages result-
- 7 ing from such selling, or giving away, to be recov-
- 8 ered in an action on the case.
