## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-THREE.

AN ACT to amend chapter one hundred and fortythree of the revised statutes relative to the insane hospital.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section two of chapter two hundred 2 and fifty-six of the public laws of the year one 3 thousand eight hundred and seventy-four, is hereby 4 revived, reading as follows:

5 "The said trustees shall appoint a superintend-6 ent, and a steward and treasurer, subject to the 7 approval of and to hold office during the pleasure 8 of the governor and council, and all other officers 9 necessary for the efficient and economical manage-10 ment of the business of the institution; all appoint11 ments shall be made according to the by-laws.12 The salaries of all such officers shall be fixed by13 the trustees, subject to the approval of the governor14 and council."

SECT. 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent 2 with this act are hereby repealed.
