STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-THREE.

AN ACT to regulate costs in the seizure of intoxicating liquors under chapter twenty-seven of the revised statutes and amendments thereto.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. When an officer seizes intoxicating

- 2 liquors and the vessels containing them, under
- 3 chapter twenty-seven of the revised statutes and
- 4 amendments thereto, at the same time and place,
- 5 although directed to one or more names, or desig-
- 6 nated by different marks, against liquors so seized.
- 7 he shall issue but one libel, to be filed as provided.
- 8 in section forty-two of said chapter; and when
- 9 seizure is made as aforesaid without a warrant first
- 10 obtained, but one warrant shall be issued.

- Sect. 2. When more than one package of
- 2 liquors is described in the same libel, ten cents shall
- 3 be taxed and allowed the officer for each additional
- 4 package so described.
 - Sect. 3. The form of monition and notice shall
- 2 be varied to conform to the requirements of sec-
- 3 tions one and two.
