STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of the State Prison.

Resolved, That the sum of ten thousand dollars

- 2 be and is hereby appropriated for the benefit of the
- 3 state prison, for general expenses and transaction
- 4 of business, for the year eighteen hundred and
- 5 eighty-four, to be expended under the direction of
- 6 the warden.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

For the last two years there has been a deficiency of \$13,700, and there is an annual deficiency that is embarrassing to the business of the prison, and has to be provided for by each legislature. If the sum of \$10,000 is appropriated for 1884, there will be a large saving to the State.
