STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-THREE.

AN ACT to prevent the fraudulent removal or concealment of mortgaged personal property.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Whoever with the fraudulent intent to place

- 2 mortgaged personal property beyond the control
- 3 of the mortgagee, removes or conceals, or aids or
- 4 abets in removing or concealing the same, and any
- 5 mortgagor of such property who assents to such
- 6 removal or concealment, shall be punished by fine
- 7 not exceeding one thousand dollars, or by impris-
- 8 onment not exceeding one year.
