STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE making an appropriation in favor of the Female Orphan Asylum of Portland, and for the support of soldiers' orphans therein, for the years eighteen hundred and eighty-three, and eighteen hundred and eighty-four.

Resolved, That the sum of one thousand dollars 2 be, and hereby is appropriated for the benefit of 3 the Female Orphan Asylum of Portland, and for 4 the support of soldiers' orphans therein, of which 5 there shall be paid the sum of five hundred dollars 6 in eighteen hundred and eighty-three, and five 7 hundred dollars in eighteen hundred and eighty-8 four.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The Female Orphan Asylum of Portland, is supported mainly by a fund derived from private donations. Among the beneficiaries are several children of soldiers, and this appropriation is asked mainly for their support. As the institution receives orphans from any portion of the State, it is thought that the aid requested should be granted.
