STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of the Maine Insane Hospital.

Resolved, That the trustees of the Maine Insane 2 Hospital are hereby authorized to take in charge 3 the erection and construction of a new pavilion or 4 building similar in design to the new pavilion re-5 cently erected; for the relief of the male wings of 6 the hospital buildings, including the furnishing of 7 heating apparatus, plumbing, elevators and every 8 thing necessary to complete the said building ready 9 for occupancy by patients, and the sum of thirty 10 thousand dollars is hereby appropriated for the pur-11 pose, the cost of the same in no event to exceed 12 said sum, the bills for the expenditures of said 13 money to be approved by the governor and council, 14 plans and specifications of said building and fittings 15 shall be made by the trustees and the erection and 16 completion of said building and putting in fittings 17 as above stated including the purchasing of ma-18 terials shall be done by contract or contracts and 19 the trustees shall superintend the work as it pro-20 gresses; also resolved that the sum of ten thousand 21 dollars is hereby appropriated for finishing the new 22 building or pavilion recently erected for use of said 23 said hospital including the furnishing of heating 24 apparatus, plumbing, elevators and all necessary 25 grading of the grounds, the same to be done under 26 direction of the trustees.
