STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-THREE.

AN ACT to authorize county commissioners to causerepairs upon county roads and bridges in unincorporated townships and tracts of land, in cases of sudden injury.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives. in Leyislature assembled, as follows

SECTION 1. County commissioners, in cases of 2 sudden injury to county roads and bridges in the 3 unincorporated townships and tracts of land in their 4 counties, may cause them to be repaired forthwith, 5 or as soon as they may deem necessary, and may 6 appoint an agent or agents not members of their 7 own board, to superintend the expenditure for such 8 repairs, who shall give bond as required in section 9 fifty-one of chapter six of the revised statutes, if 10 the county commissioners require it, the whole 11 expense whereof shall be added to their next 12 assessment on said lands for repairs, authorized by 13 section fifty-three of said chapter six of the revised 14 statutes and acts additional thereto and amendato-15 ry thereof, which said assessment shall create a 16 lien upon said lands for the whole amount thereof 17 as effectually as is now provided in relation to 18 repairs on such county roads.

SECT. 2. That portion of said assessment which 2 is for repairs of sudden injuries as herein provided, 3 shall be set down, in the assessment, in distinct 4 items, in a separate column or columns, and shall 5 not be discharged, under the provision of section 6 fifty-four of chapter six of the revised statutes, 7 but shall be enforced as is provided in relation to 8 such assessments for repairs when owners fail to 9, make repairs.

· SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when ap-_2 proved.
